We recognize the importance of honouring Indigenous history and culture and of moving forward in the spirit of reconciliation and respect with all First Nation, Metis and Inuit people.

It is important to acknowledge that we are not settlers on this land, but we are treaty bearers and as such we should strive to improve our own understanding of local Indigenous peoples and their cultures.
